



Whether you're looking for a casual lunch spot, a venue for a business meeting, or a pre-show meet-up, 1867 caters to all with complimentary high-speed WiFi.

Conveniently located next to the main theatre entrance, 1867 will operate weekdays from 10am to 3pm, offering a range of hot and cold beverages, beers, wines, light lunches, sweet treats, and savoury snacks.

Our varied food and drink offering will also cater to gluten-free, vegetarian and vegan diets. Moreover, we'll be open for a minimum of 90 minutes before every show and event.

In addition, the theatre's box office will now be housed within 1867, allowing customers to purchase tickets for all productions directly from the cafe counter. As you arrive for performances, a concierge desk will also be available in the main foyer of the theatre.

We can't wait to welcome you to 1867 at the Tyne Theatre & Opera House.

# Building our future

If you've visited us recently, you may have noticed that some areas of the theatre are starting to look a little different.

Thanks to funding from the North East Combined Authority and Newcastle City Council as part of Creative Council NCL, we have been able to embark on the first stage of an ambitious development project in the footprint of what was our Bistro Bar area.

These works will create a double height 'black box' performance space, removing the ceiling that was added in the 1960s. In addition to hosting a variety of entertainment, the 'black box' iteration of the Grand Saloon (its title from c. 1867) will be an adaptable space, able to improve access to and engagement with cultural activity by serving as a hub for meetings, rehearsals, workshops and more.

We're thankful to the North East Combined Authority and Creative Central NCL and our audiences for their ongoing support. The income generated from ticket sales, bar takings, donations and our Friends Club membership scheme plays a crucial role in allowing us to fund this project.

We look forward to being able to welcome even more people through our doors and to reopening this re-envisioned space for the benefit of audiences and the local community,



# **Booking and venue information**

### How to book

You can book online, over the phone or in-person at the box office. A £2 booking fee applies to all tickets, regardless of how you choose to book.

Box office opening hours (for phone and in-person bookings) are 10am-3pm\* Mon-Fri (or until show start if there is a performance that evening). For weekend performances, the box office will open 90 minutes before the start of the show.\*

We are not liable for tickets bought through third party websites and would always encourage you to book directly with the theatre.

### Access information

Due to the age of the Grade I listed building, only the Stalls level is accessible for patrons with limited mobility as we have no lift in the theatre.

We have wheelchair spaces in the stalls and there is an accessible toilet at the back of the auditorium. Assistance dogs are welcome in all areas of the theatre. Whatever access need you may have, including if you need wider seating or additional leg room, please check our website or get in touch with our team in advance of booking your seats.

### Accessibility bookings

For those requiring an essential companion, the companion ticket will be free and will need to be booked directly with our box office, who will ask for proof of entitlement. If you have any additional needs or requirements which may mean you require specific seats, you can also contact our box office team for advice.

## Concessions and family tickets

For performances where concessions are available, this applies to customers under the age of 16 and over the age of 60, unless otherwise stated. Where there is an option to book a family ticket, this refers to a family of four, consisting of one adult and three children or two adults and two children (children must be under 16.)

### Food and drink

There are bars on all levels of the theatre serving alcoholic drinks, soft drinks and snacks. Out brand new cafe, 1867, offers a range of food options, so be sure to visit and take a look.

# Children, babies and buggies

Children aged 18 months or younger classify as babes in arms and do not need a ticket. However, some shows aimed at younger children may have a different policy which will be stated in the event description on our website.

Children over 18 months will need a ticket, even if you want to keep them on your lap. We ask that if you attend with your children, you do not bring your buggy with you wherever possible, as our storage space is extremely limited. If you do bring a buggy, we will ask that you fold it away to its smaller possible size to be stored.

### Limited view seats

We are a Victorian Grade I listed building and the view from certain seats may be restricted depending on the performance. Limited view seats will be indicated on seating plans at the time of booking.

### Refunds and exchanges

All tickets are non-refundable and non-exchangeable (unless a show is cancelled/rescheduled).


